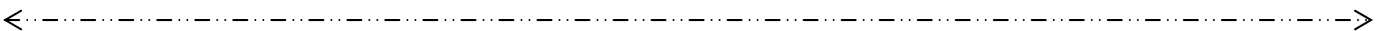
If you would like «Forename» to attend, the cost will be approximately £100.

As you approach Newby Bridge, turn right at the roundabout along the A592 to Windermere and Bowness. Proceed along the road for about 3 and a half miles then fork right along a minor road signposted "Great Tower Scout Camp" (Also Park Cliffe Commercial Camp Site) The main entrance is half a mile up the road on the left-hand side between the two tall wooden towers.</p>
