

Make a scale model of an 80m hill.

Use a sheet of carbon paper to trace the contour lines above onto polystyrene tiles or similar. Place each contour line on a separate tile.

Carefully cut out the tiles, and glue them on top of each other to create the shape of the hill.

Spread plaster over the model to create sloping hills, instead of the step effect created by the tiles.

Once the model is dry, you can finish it off by painting.
